The Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA) and the WHMIS Regulation has been amended to adopt new, international standards that are part of the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS). The changes reflect recent amendments to the federal Hazardous Products Act and new Hazardous Products Regulations.
